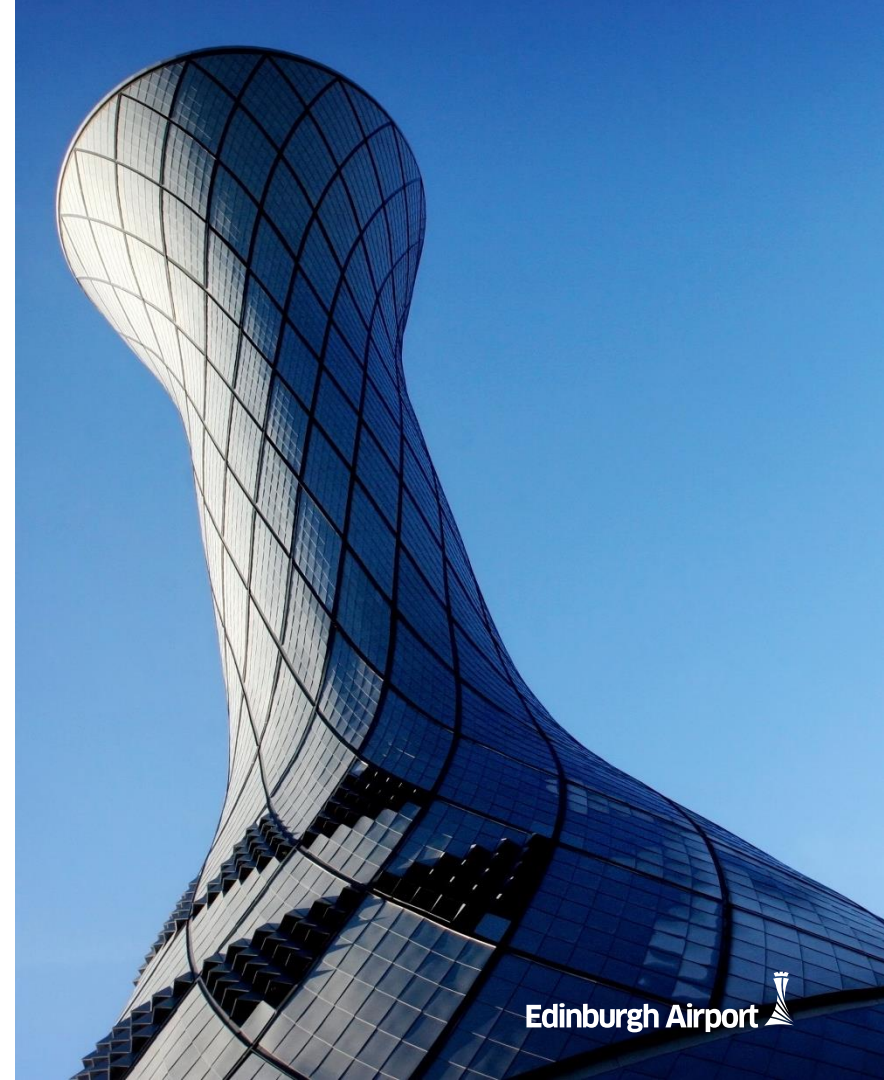
“Day in the Life” Learning Opportunities

Please note that we are required to create a temporary airport ID pass for all participants. To support this you must have:

- Aged 18 or over: valid passport or UK driving licence.
- Aged 17 or under: valid passport or UK driving licence in the first instance. However, if you're still at school, a letter from school or college confirming your identity can be accepted instead. For care-experienced young people under 17 who are not attending school, a letter from your social worker can also be accepted.
